Key Responsibilities:

You will be working within a small specialist team of engineers reporting to a line manager who will be responsible for your development and mandatory training.

You will be required to assist in the customisation and installation of covert technical surveillance assets in support of both MPS operations and National CT operations.

The portfolio roles that you will be interviewed against will have the same technical requirement. You will be required to procure, develop and deliver both audio and video surveillance solutions in-conjunction with your line managers operational objectives and therefore you will need to demonstrate on interview a basic audio, video and transmission medium concept, together with an understanding of IP connectivity.

Both portfolio roles are in operational theatre and you will be required to work outside of your agreed managed hours to deliver the set objective.

You may also be required to travel as part of a team OMPD for durations up to 5 days and on occasion, be involved in sporadic back to back deployments greater than 12 days – however, this is dependent upon what portfolio you are selected for.

These portfolios roles allow an opportunity for you to participate in an on-call rota and this will carry an addition weighting allowance to your pay of either 5%, 10% or 12.5% subject to the rota you are scheduled on.

Both portfolio roles require the applicant to have a practical and flexible engineering approach and to have a positive attitude with regard to the protracted and challenging theatre that you will be subjected to - under TSU Operating Procedure **OP016** and **OP014**, in accordance with National Police Chiefs Council (NPCC) - Authorised Professional Practice (APP).
