



The Bunker - South East Data Centre

The Kent bunker was built by the MOD as a command and control centre. The construction and security standards are what you might expect of such a purpose built fortress. Patrolled and monitored 24/7/365 by our specialist on-site security teams, located 30 metres beneath a perimeter fenced site with reinforced concrete walls, steel doors weighing several tons and EMP and tempest shielding.

Bunker onsite security includes

- 3m thick walls
- Solid steel blast protection doors
- 24 hour on-site technical and security team
- On-site MOD trained guard dogs
- Infrared CCTV
- Military electromagnetic pulse protection
- Tempest RFI intrusion protection
- Sophisticated access controls.

Data Floor

- Secure shared or dedicated partitioned areas
- Space from a quarter rack to a dedicated suite or vault.

Power & Air Conditioning

- N+1 Redundant air conditioning units to guarantee stable temperature and humidity
- Redundant UPS conditioned power @ N+1
- Dual HV redundant power supplies from physically diverse paths
- Dual 1700 KVA auto generator back-up sets
- Dual HV sub stations.

Security

- SCADA Environmental and Power Monitoring system
- Early Smoke Detection Apparatus
- Fire suppression system
- CCTV system
- 24/7/365 video recording and monitoring
- Visual verification of all persons entering the data floor
- 24/7/365 manned guardroom (fitted with bullet-proof glass)
- 24/7/365 on-site security staff (ex-military & police)
- Random patrols with guard dogs
- Infrared cameras
- Vehicular gate with control barrier
- On-site parking.

Secured Networks

- Multiple fibre providers
- Multiple Internet Service Providers
- Diverse independent telco risers from public highway to data floor
- Choice of telecommunications service providers
- Satellite dish space available - subject to planning
- Microwave space available - subject to planning
- Private MPLS network.

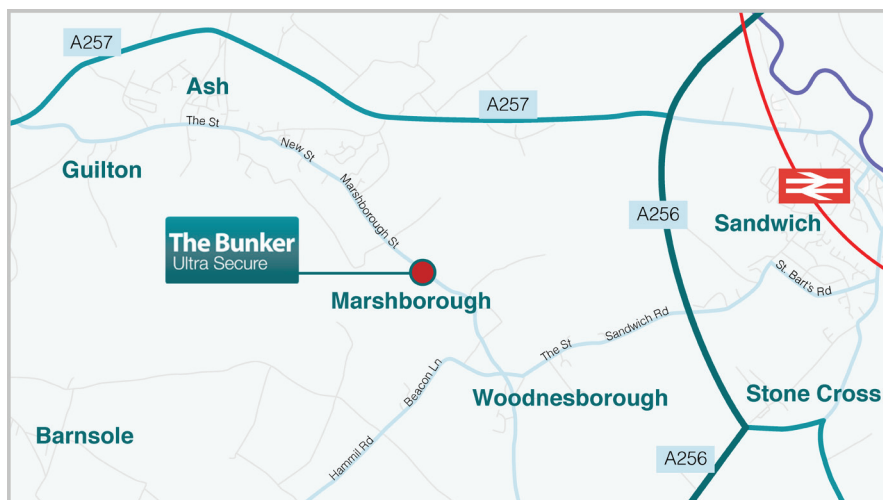
Directions to The Bunker's Ash Radar Station Data Centre:

Ash Radar Station, Marshborough Road, Sandwich, Kent, CT13 0PL

- From the A2 at Canterbury. About 1 or 2 miles past Canterbury take the exit for Bridge. Left at the T-junction at top of the exit slip
- Follow the country lane towards Howletts Zoo Park (left when you come to a small roundabout)
- Follow road past Zoo Park to Littlebourne
- At Littlebourne take a right at the T-junction with A257
- Follow A257 through Wingham
- Approx 2.5 miles past Wingham take right turn towards Ash
- Follow road through Ash village for approx 1 mile
- Just after Ash village, the road forks on a bend, take right fork onto New Street towards Eastry
- Approx 1 mile on right hand side is the perimeter security fencing and entrance to The Bunker.
